JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

- 1. That Ray A. Hewerdine is the current owner and operator ("Respondent") of a facility located at 1700 E County Road in Ludlow Township, rural Champaign County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Ludlow/Hewerdine, Ray A.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0198115004.
 - 3. That Respondent has owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on November 29, 2012, Mike Mullins of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Champaign Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on <u>/-8-/3</u>, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. <u>70/0 2780 000 2 1/67 5584</u>.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Mike Mullins during the course of his November 29, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>February 15, 2013</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois

Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.





General Comments:

Ownership: Confirmed. The Champaign County Supervisor of Assessments confirmed the property is owned by Ray A. Hewerdine.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Land Pollution received a complaint of open burning of tires on July 31st, 2012 at an address on 1700E County Road in Ludlow Township, rural Champaign County.

An investigation on August 2, 2012 found wastes had been burned on the property and that several waste/used tires were being hap-hazardously stored improperly on the property. An Administrative Citation Warning Notice (ACWN) was sent on August 22, 2012.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Land Pollution received a complaint of open burning on November 28th, 2012 at 3467 County Road, in Ludlow Township, rural Champaign County.

The purpose of this inspection was to determine regulatory status and evaluate compliance with the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and Title 35 Illinois Administrative Code, Subtitle G: Land Pollution (Regulations).

November 29, 2012 Observations:

I arrived on this site at approximately 10:00 a.m. The purpose was to re-inspect the property after a complaint of open burning of wastes in July/August 2012 and investigate a newly received complaint of open burning. No one was at the residence to answer the door. I then proceeded to walk around the barn looking for a burn barrel or burn area.

As I walked around the property I observed an approximately 1000 gallon steel tank that was being used to dispose of wastes by open burning (photos 1,2). The burn tank was about ¾ full of ash which indicated that the tank has been used for an extended period of time. Within the ash was observed metal cans, metal pipe (likely electrical conduit), and the metal springs from a household chair. Also observed near the burn tank was a flatbed truck with a pile of ash (photo 3). The ash likely was from the burn tank or nearby burn barrels.

I observed the semi-truck tires were no on observed (photo 4). No receipts had been received demonstrating that removed wastes had been properly disposed.

I left the property at approximately 10:15 a.m.

Violations of Sections 55(a)(1) and 55(k)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (Act) would be considered resolved.

Apparent violations observed continuing during this inspection:

Sections 21(a), 21(e), and 21(p)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (Act) would be continuing at this location and the new violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act was observed.


