#### JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012).

#### FACTS

- That John Wayne and Jerry Lee Squier d/b/a Squier Auto Sales & Salvage are the
  owners and operators ("Respondents") of a facility located at 1905 North County Road 2770,
   Fountain Green, Hancock County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois
  Environmental Protection Agency as Squier Auto Salvage.
  - 2. That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 0678070003.
  - That Respondents have owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on May 15, 2014, Gerald McGhee of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on <u>6-4-14</u>, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. <u>7012</u> 0470 0001 3000 8494

#### **VIOLATIONS**

Based upon direct observations made by Gerald McGhee during the course of the May 15, 2014 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondents caused or allowed water to accumulate in used/waste tires, violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2012).

#### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2012), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>July 28, 2014</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each

violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2012), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

## PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2012). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

#### Narrative

On May 15, 2014, I conducted a Tire Storage Inspection from 11:45 a.m. until 12:10 p.m. at the subject site located at 1905 N. County Rd. 2770 in Fountain Green, Illinois. The facility is owned and operated by John Wayne Squier d/b/a Squier Auto Sales & Salvage and Jerry Lee Squier d/b/a Squier Auto Sales & Salvage. (See Warranty Deed and Quit Claim Deed).

The inspection was conducted as a follow up to an Administrative Citation Warning Notice sent to the owners d/b/a Squier Auto Salvage on March 4, 2014. A compliance proposal was due by March 19, 2014. No proposal has been received by the Agency. The compliance deadline was May 1, 2014. I interviewed Arthur Squier, the manager on site.

I observed about 150 used tires outside. Some of the used tires were on the ground or on racks within 25 feet of buildings located on site. Many were allowed to accumulate water. (See photographs 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14, and 15). Sampling revealed the presence of larval mosquitos.

I observed a semi-trailer containing about 200 used tires. (See photographs 11 and 13).

Mr. Squier could not produce receipts for disposal of used tires from the site. The Used and/or Waste Tire Activity Notification and Registration Form has not been submitted and the required annual fee has not been paid.

The following continuing apparent violations were observed:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 21(k) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(k)), no person shall fail or refuse to pay any fee imposed under this Act.
  - A violation of Section 21(k) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(k)) is alleged for the following reason: John Wayne Squier and Jerry Lee Squier as owners d/b/a Squier Auto Sales and Salvage failed to submit the required annual fee.
