
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.A. Burke):

The Sanitary District of Decatur filed two separate actions seeking relief from water quality standards for its sewage treatment plant at 501 Dipper Lane, Decatur, Macon County that discharges to the Sangamon River. This docket relates to the District’s request for a site-specific rule on water quality standards for nickel. The District also filed an extension for a 2010 variance granting similar relief (PCB 14-111).

The District was previously given a June 30, 2017 deadline for a status report in both cases. Similar to the Board’s order moved today in the related case, the District must file its status report in this rulemaking by May 12, 2017. In addition to the previously requested information, the report should also include the District’s position on how this rulemaking is impacted by (1) newly adopted Section 38.5 of the Environmental Protection Act, and (2) the conversion of the District’s variance petition to a time-limited water quality standard under that section.
