ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.M. Keenan):

On June 9, 2017, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which B Petro Corporation may appeal a May 4, 2017 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). The joint notice was timely filed because it was postmarked on or before the filing deadline. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2016); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.404(b), 105.406. The determination concerns B Petro's underground storage tank (UST) site located at 306 North Canal in Annawan, Henry County. The Agency modified B Petro's amended site investigation budget and modified B Petro's actual costs budget for Stage 2 and 3 site investigation.

The Board extends the appeal period until September 10, 2017, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2016); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If B Petro fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
