ORDER OF THE BOARD (by K. Papadimitriu):

On June 8, 2007, the Office of the Attorney General, on behalf of the People of the State of Illinois (People), filed a four-count complaint against C. Grantham Company (Grantham) pertaining to Grantham’s former truck terminal at 7401 Bunkum Road in East St. Louis, St. Clair County. The complaint alleges that Grantham violated the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(j), 21(k), 21(p)(5), 55(a)(4), 55(c), 55(d)(1), 55(e), 55.6(b) (2016)) and Board’s regulations (35 Ill. Adm. Code 809.201, 848.202(b)(2), (5)). The People allege that Grantham violated these provisions by hauling special waste without a permit, storing used or waste tires without the required registration or management, and open dumping waste in a manner that resulted in disease vectors proliferating at its site.

On July 5, 2017, the People filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss the complaint without prejudice and without costs under 735 ILCS 5/2-1009 and 5/5-117 (2016). The motion states that Grantham was dissolved on April 9, 2010, and that there is no known service address for Grantham. Motion at 2. The Board received no response to the motion. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500(d). The Board grants the motion, dismisses the complaint without prejudice, and closes the docket.
