ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

This matter comes before the Board upon an April 25, 1984 filing on behalf of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) encaptioned "Motion for Leave to File Answer," but which is apparently a motion for extension of time in which to file the Agency record. The Agency states that is received the "Petition for a Hearing" (presumably the petition for permit appeal) and that "the answer in this Petition" (presumably the filing of the record) is due on April 25, 1984, but that the "Agency is not able to compile and file . . . its entire record" until May 7, 1984. No other reason for the late filing is given. The Board is reluctant to grant such motions in the absence of any substantial reason. Nonetheless, the motion is hereby granted.
