**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**



The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on March 15, 2018, at 10:45 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.
