At the hearing on May 1, 2018, and in post-hearing briefs, each party should consider: (1) proposing a remedy for a violation, if any (including whether to impose a civil penalty), and supporting its position with facts and arguments that address any or all of the factors in Section 33(c) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act); and (2) proposing a civil penalty, if any (including a specific total dollar amount and the portion of that amount attributable to the respondent's economic benefit, if any, from delayed compliance), and supporting its position with facts and arguments that address any or all of the factors in Section 42(h) of the Act.
