AC 18-8	County of Jackson v. William Martin, Jr. (Administrative Citation) – The Board found that respondent had violated 21(p)(1) and 21(p)(7) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), 21(p)(7) (2016)), and ordered respondent to pay a total civil penalty of \$3,000.	5-0
AC 18-9	County of LaSalle v. Jeffrey Schuster (Administrative Citation) – The Board directed complainant to file information documenting that it filed the administrative citation within 10 days after serving Mr. Schuster on or before May 3, 2018, or the administrative citation will be subject to dismissal.	5-0

Engineered Plastic Components, Inc., an Iowa corporation (Enforcement – Land) – In this land enforcement action concerning a Champaign County facility, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2016)), accepted a stipulation and settlement agreement, and ordered respondents to pay a total civil penalty of \$55,000 and to cease and desist from further violations.	5-0

IEPA (Tax Certification – Water) – The Board found and certified that specified facilities of Wabash Valley Service Company located in White County are pollution control facilities for the purpose of preferential tax treatment under the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2016)).	5-0
