Illinois Pollution Control Board Grants 45-day Provisional Variance to the Village of Panama

Chicago - The Illinois Pollution Control Board granted the Village of Panama a 45-day provisional variance from various effluent standards. The provisional variance is for activities at the wastewater treatment facility in the Village of Panama, Bond County. It will allow for the removal of sludge and installation of a rock filter.

This action, docketed as PCB 02-35, was taken by the Board upon notification by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency that compliance with certain effluent standards, would impose an arbitrary or unreasonable hardship on the Village of Panama.
