JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

- 1. That John K. Croslow d/b/a Croslow's Auto Repair is the current operator ("Respondent") of a facility located at 1421 Lexington Avenue, Lawrenceville, Lawrence County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Croslow's Auto Repair (f/k/a Croslow's Shell Station).
 - 2. That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 1010155024.
 - 3. That Respondent has operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on May 30, 2013 Garrison Gross, of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 7-11-13, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7012 0470 0001 2998 6123

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Garrison Gross during the course of the May 30, 2013 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent failed to collect a fee required under Section 55.8, a violation of Section 55(k)(2) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(2) (2010).
- (2) That Respondent failed to file a return required under Section 55.10, a violation of Section 55(k)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(3) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

On May 17, 2012, the Board found John K. Croslow in violation of Sections 55(k)(2) and 55(k)(3) of the Act in AC 12-43.

Because this Administrative Citation addresses a second or subsequent violation of Sections 55(k)(2) and 55(k)(3) of the Act, pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for each violation, for a total of <u>Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>August 15, 2013</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Three Thousand Dollar (\$3,000.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Subject: Tire Storage-Exempt Site Inspection at Croslow's Auto Repair

General Remarks: A Tire Storage-Exempt Site Inspection was conducted on Thursday, May 30, 2013 at Croslow's Auto Repair. The inspection was conducted by Garrison Gross representing the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land. The site is located at the northeast corner of 15th Street and Lexington Avenue. The address is 1421 Lexington Avenue, Lawrenceville, Illinois 62439. The inspection was performed as a follow up to a previous inspection conducted on March 1, 2012. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were mostly cloudy skies, 82° F, and windy.

Inspection Findings: The inspection began at approximately 10:20 A.M. I entered the site and spoke with the business owner, John Croslow. I identified myself and explained the reason for the inspection. Mr. Croslow stated that he had corrected the violations and was disposing of tires properly. He provided tire transporter receipts showing the disposal of waste tires to J & R Used Tire Service. Waste tires were being picked up on a regular basis. Fifty-one (51) tires were disposed on April 16, 2013 (photo 001). Twenty-six (26) tires were disposed on May 14, 2013. Mr. Croslow said he did not sell very many tires and told the inspector he was trying to get rid of the waste tires. He was unable to provide any receipts showing the retail sale of tires and he could not provide any Department of Revenue ST-8's. Mr. Croslow said he received a letter from the Agency saying that he was exempt from collecting the tire user fee due the small number of tires that he sold. I asked to see a copy of the letter. Mr. Croslow said he didn't have the letter but thought his accountant might have it. I asked him to send me a copy of the letter.

Mr. Croslow provided invoices for tires he purchased for resale. The April 15, 2013, Neal Tire invoice showed that he was not charged the tire user fee (photo 002). The fee was shown but then deducted from the sale price. The tire purchased from Best One Tire on February 12, 2013, was sold out-of-state in Indiana (photo 003). The invoice showed the .25 cents state tire fee was collected for that tire. The invoices did not show that Mr. Croslow was paying the Illinois tire user fee to the supplier. The recycle notice was posted at the sales area as required. Mark Randolph was contracted to recycle the antifreeze.

I continued the inspection by walking and photographing the site. Mr. Croslow accompanied me during the inspection. Thirty-six (36) waste tires were observed north of the business. The tires were stored under a carport structure (photo 004). All of the tires were dry. Approximately twenty (20) resalable used tires were stored inside the business. One (1) 55-gallon drum was stored inside the shop (photo 005). The drum was labeled as used antifreeze. One (1) metal storage tank was located on the east side of the business (photo 006). The storage tank was labeled as used oil. Based on the conditions at the time of the inspection, the facility should be regulated as a tire storage-exempt facility. The inspection ended at approximately 10:40 A.M.

Additional Remarks:

Information obtained from the Illinois Department of Revenue indicates that John K. Croslow has not been submitting ST-8's for retail tire sales. The Agency has not received the documents that were requested.

Inspection Site Sketch










