### JURISDICTION

The Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the statutory authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by section 4(e) and 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("act") 415 ILCS 5/4(e), 5/31.1, and delegated to Vermilion County Pursuant to section 4(r) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/4(r).

### FACTS

- That Respondents, Marian and Russell Herbold, are, and were at all times relevant to this Administrative Citation, the owner of property located at the area of 614 Poland Road, Danville, more particularly Latitude 40.1850, Longitude -87.6155.
- 2. That said property is vacant land which is not permitted as a sanitary landfill or dump area.

 That on 8/05/2013 Douglas Toole of the Vermilion County Health Department inspected the above-described property. Douglas Toole's Affidavit and a copy of his inspection report are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

### VIOLATIONS

- 1. On the basis of direct observations personally made by Douglas Toole, the County of Vermilion has determined that on 8/05/13 :
  - A. The Respondent was allowing the open dumping of waste which resulted in litter in violation of Section 21(p)(1).

B. The Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of any waste which results in the deposition of general construction or demolition debris and clean construction and demolition debris in violation of Section 21(p)(7).

#### **CIVIL PENALTY**

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4), Respondent herein is subject to a civil penalty of \$1,500.00 for each violation of each provision under subsection p of Section 21, plus any hearing costs incurred by the Board should the Respondent elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described herein below.

### PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

You have the right to contest this Administrative Citation under Section 31.1(d) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d). If you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, you must file a petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control, at the State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. Such Petition for Review must be filed with thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation, or a default judgment will be issued by the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition for Review should be filed with the Vermilion County State's Attorney's Office, Courthouse, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 7 N Vermilion Street, Danville, Illinois, 61832.

If you acknowledge the violation herein, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than 2-8-2010. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of the Administrative Citation within thirtyfive (35) days of the service hereof and have not paid the civil penalty by the due date stated above, or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against you.

When payment is made, your check should be made payable to the County of Vermilion, Illinois and mailed to the Vermilion County Health Department, 200

South College Street, Danville, Illinois, 61832, together with a completed copy of the remittance form attached hereto.

If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default or finding after hearing, is not paid when due, the Vermilion County State's Attorney may initiate proceedings in the Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty and any hearing costs of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the State's Attorney's Office will seek to recover its costs of litigation

#### OPEN DUMP INSPECTION NARRATIVE

This unpermitted open dump was reinspected on August 5, 2013, by Douglas Toole of the Vermilion County Health Department. The weather was cloudy, dry, breezy and about 75 degrees Fahrenheit. Five photos were taken of the site.

The site is located in Vermilion County, at 614 Poland Road in rural Danville, Illinois.

#### INSPECTORS FINDINGS

I arrived at 614 Poland Road in rural Danville, Illinois at about 10:25 a.m. on August 5, 2013 to check the status of the cleanup on the property. No one one appeared to be home when I arrived, and no one accompanied me during the reinspection.

Near a storage building behind the house at 614 Poland Road, I observed plastic buckets, tires, scrap metal and other items (photos 1-3).

On the west side of the property behind the buildings, I observed tires, remodeling waste, concrete and other refuse (photo 4).

I then went to the south-central part of the property, where I observed a pile of branches, boards, household garbage, scrap metal, demolition debris and other refuse (photo 5).

Many of the items I observed on August 5, 2103 appeared to be items I had observed during my previous inspections of the property. There was no evidence of recent waste-burning at the site. I left the property at about 10:35 a.m.

On the Inspection Report Checklist for this reinspection, I estimated that there were 80 cubic yards of waste on the site. No measurements were performed to arrive at that estimation, only my observations at the time. The actual amount of waste on the site may vary significantly from that estimation.

#### SUMMARY OF APPARENT VIOLATIONS

#### ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT (415 ILCS 5/1 et seq.)

Section 21 (a) of the Act: No person shall ... cause or allow the open dumping of any waste. The open dumping of waste was observed on the site.

Section 21 (d)(1) of the Act: No person shall  $\dots$  conduct any waste storage, wastetreatment, or waste-disposal operation without  $\dots$  a permit granted by the Agency. No Agency permit to conduct a waste storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation for the site was issued.

Section 21 (d)(2) of the Act: No person shall ... conduct any waste-storage, wastetreatment, or waste disposal operation ... in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board under the Act. Violations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board Regulations were observed at the site where waste storage, waste-treatment, or wastedisposal operations were taking place.

Section 21(e) of the Act: No person shall ... dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste ... except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards thereunder. The storage and disposal of waste was occurring at a site which did not meet the requirements of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act and the Illinois Pollution Control Board Regulations.

Section 21 (p)(1) of the Act: No person shall ... cause or allow the open dumping of any waste which results in ... litter. Open dumping of waste resulting in litter was observed at the site.

Section 21 (p)(7) of the Act: No person shall ... cause or allow the open dumping of any waste which results in ... the deposition of general construction or demolition debris; or clean construction or demolition debris. Open dumping resulting in the deposition of general and clean construction and demolition debris was observed at the site.


Section 55 (a) of the Act: No person shall ... cause or allow the open dumping of any used or waste tire. Open dumping of used and waste tires was observed at the site.

### ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD; 35 ILLINOIS ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, SUBTITLE G (REGULATIONS)

Section 812.101 of the Regulations: ... All persons, except those specifically exempted by Section 21(d) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) [415 ILCS 5/21(d)], shall submit to the Agency an application for a permit to develop and operate a landfill. The application must contain the information required by this Subpart and by Section 39(a) of the Act, except as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 817. No such application for a permit to develop and operate a landfill was submitted.
