

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On June 14, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (Authority) may appeal a May 10, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency denied part of the Authority's request for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund regarding a leaking underground storage tank site associated with the Tri State Tollway in Alsip, Cook County. The Board extends the appeal period until September 12, 2002, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If the Authority fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
