1 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: Let's get started.  
2 It's now 1:31. This is the hearing in the  
3 Identical-in-Substance Rulemaking R14-7, in the matter  
4 of National Ambient Air Quality Standards Update, USEPA  
5 regulations, July 1st, 2013 through December 31st, 2013.

6 MR. MATOESIAN: I'm sorry. Did you mean  
7 R14-17?

8 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: R14-17. Isn't that what  
9 I said?

10 MR. MATOESIAN: You said seven.

11 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: Okay, it's R14-17. Thank  
12 you.

13 The Board adopted a proposal for public  
14 comment on March 20th in this. The proposal for public  
15 comment appeared in the April 11th issue of the Illinois  
16 Register. We're holding a public hearing in this to  
17 satisfy the federal requirement that the state conduct  
18 a public hearing on a matter that would result in a  
19 state implementation or SIP revision.

20 My name is Mike McCambridge. Attending  
21 Board member with me is Jennifer Burke. That's all the  
22 people we have here in Chicago.

23 Could the people in Springfield identify  
24 themselves, for the record?

1 MR. MATOESIAN: Yes. My name is  
2 Charles Matoesian, I'm an attorney appearing for the  
3 Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. With me today  
4 I have Jackie Sims who is a regulatory emit manager in  
5 the Bureau of Air, and Yoginger Mahajan who is an  
6 environmental protection engineer in the Bureau of Air.

7 MS. NEWMAN: Connie Newman for the Pollution  
8 Control Board.

9 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: The only filing I've  
10 received from the agency is your appearance in this.

11 MR. MATOESIAN: That's correct.

12 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: That's correct. The  
13 subject of this, a couple of USEPA updates to federal  
14 reference methods and equivalent methods that occurred  
15 on July 3rd, 2013 and August 5th, 2013, and November 12,  
16 2013, by publication in the Federal Register. USEPA  
17 rolled those method updates into the list of designated  
18 reference and equivalent methods that it made available  
19 on December 17th, 2013. So, essentially, this  
20 proceeding is just updating the incorporation by  
21 reference of the list of designated methods to the  
22 December 17, 2013 version. That's all I have to say  
23 about it. Does the agency have anything?

24 MR. MATOESIAN: We have no comment, sir.

1 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: Okay. Public comment  
2 period in this will end I believe it was March 24th. We  
3 will promptly move this before the Board, I believe that  
4 is the June 5, 2014 meeting for adoption and follow that  
5 by prompt filing.

6 If that's all, we'll adjourn this hearing.


7 Seeing nothing, we're adjourned.
