The text of the recently adopted amendments is attached in the format that I will use to update our database: plain text with all additions and deletions completed.

As to the omitted comma, I observe that the text on file does not include the comma. Even so small an omission should be done by formal amendment. I have marked the correction for a future proceeding. Part 243 will be open for amendment again before the end of this year. USEPA designated a new federal equivalent method on January 26, 2016, so the Board will need to complete amendments before January 26, 2017. I will include the correction to Section 243.105(b)(2) in that proceeding. I have not yet reserved docket numbers for the next round of IIS amendments, but I will request docket number R17-1 for the NAAQS update.

John T.: Please include this e-mail as a comment in the R16-2 docket. If possible, reserve docket R17-1 for the following-captioned proceeding: UST Update, USEPA Amendments (January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016), R17-1. I will give you the full IIS reservation list later.
