#### ROLL CALL

The Assistant Clerk called the roll. Three Board Members answered present.

Germany's Energiewende (Energy Transition)	Kristin Munsch, Citizens
Ms. Munsch provided a PowerPoint presentation on key elements	Utility Board
of Germany's Energy Transition discussed at the June 2016 Berlin	
Seminar on Energy Policy. She underscored Germany's holistic,	
community-driven approach to managing energy needs and	
shifting generation from fossil fuels and nuclear power to	
renewable sources (e.g., off-shore wind power) and energy	
efficiency measures. Noting the transition's rapid pace, Ms.	
Munsch further explained that the move to carbon-free energy	
production enjoys wide political support —and indeed depends on	
government leadership as well as private investment and	
involvement — and attempts to address impacts on a diverse range	
of affected parties, from organized labor to refugees. She also	
reviewed the challenges and issues posed by the transition,	
including the need for Germany to boost energy efficiency, replace	
feed-in tariffs with procurement by auction, and appropriately	
balance energy markets. Ms. Munsch closed with a look at a	
citizen-driven renewable energy initiative in rural Feldheim, a pig	
farming community that meets its energy needs in a closed loop of	
wind and biogas generation as well as battery storage. A copy of

(www.ipcb.state.il.us). The Board took no action on this matter.
