RECOMMENDATION

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

1. On December 26, 2012, the Illinois EPA received a request from Charles Leary (log number TC-27-12, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

2. The applicant's address is: RR#1 Box 44
Little York, IL 61453-9502

3. The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located at SW ¼ of Section 22, T12N, R4W of 4th PM in Warren County, at the above street address and consist of the following:

Livestock waste management facilities consisting of one concrete manure pit (approximately 191 ft. x 51 ft. x 8 ft. deep) with two concrete pump out pits (approximately 4.5 ft. x 4.5. ft. x 8 ft. deep) and the portion of slotted concrete flooring oer the manure pits in building # 1; one concrete manure pit (approximately 191 ft. x 51 ft. x 8 ft. deep) with two concrete pump out pits (approximately 4.5 ft. x 4.5. ft. x 8 ft. deep) and the portion of the slotted concrete flooring over the manure pits in building #2.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport and/or store livestock wastes prior to cropland application, and are further described in Exhibit A.

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4. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2012), defines "pollution control facilities" as:

"any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: (a) eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or (b) treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property."


5. Pollution control facilities are entitled to preferential tax treatment, 35 ILCS 200/11-5.

6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facilities, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

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WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport and/or store livestock wastes prior to cropland application.

These facilities are further described in the enclosed applications and supporting documents.

Based on the information included in this submittal, it is our engineering judgment that the above proposed facilities may be considered "Pollution Control Facilities" under 35 IAC 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in this section, and therefore eligible for tax certification from the Illinois Pollution Control Board. The Bureau of Water therefore recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification for these facilities.

The application actually included tax certification requests for two separate facilities. The facilities have different tax ID numbers, this facility is the new structure that was finished in 2007. The other facility was completed in 1997. The other facility has been logged in with a receipt date of 12/26/2012.

According to Mr. Leary, each building, 2 total at each facility have pump out structures measuring 4.5 feet x 4.5 feet for the whole depth of the pit on each end of the pit.

Mr. Leary also indicated that each of the pits have slotted concrete slab flooring that cover the entire pit area.

Mr. Leary also confirmed that the waste stored within the pits gets land applied on their own farmed lands.

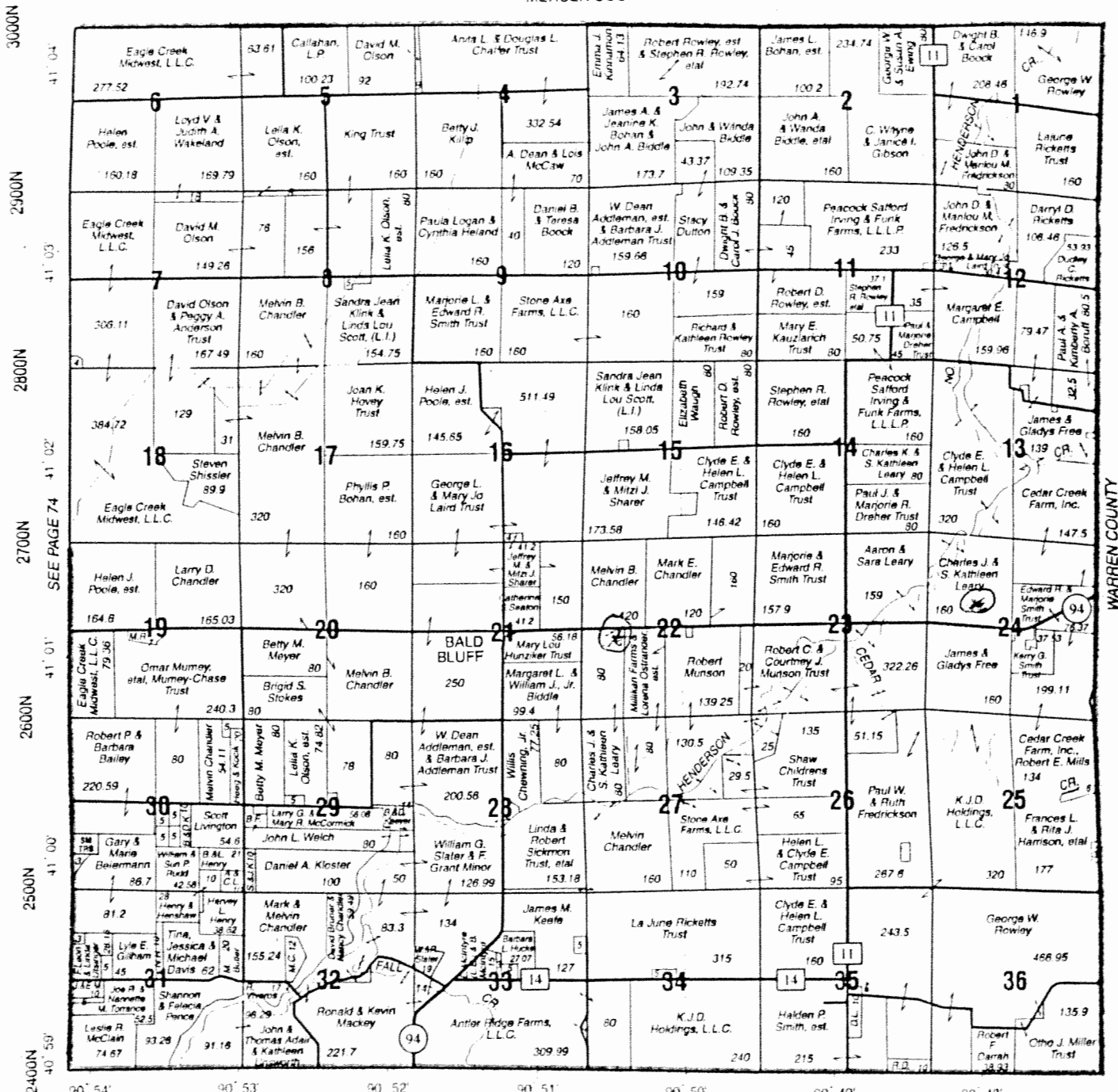
