<u>R19-5</u>	Wastewater Pretreatment Update, USEPA Regulations (January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018) (Water) — The Board dismissed this reserved identical-in-substance docket because the United States Environmental Protection Agency did not amend its wastewater pretreatment regulations during the update period of January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018.	5-0

<u>R19-7</u>	Definition of VOM Update, USEPA Regulations (January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018) (Air) – The Board dismissed this reserved identical-in-substance docket because the United States Environmental Protection Agency did not amend the definition of "volatile organic material" during the update period of January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018.	5-0
<u>R19-8</u>	SDWA Update, USEPA Regulations (January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018) (Public Water Supply) — The Board dismissed this reserved identical-in-substance docket because the United States Environmental Protection Agency did not amend its drinking water regulations during the update period of January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018.	5-0
<u>R19-9</u>	UIC Update, USEPA Regulations (January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018) (Land) – The Board dismissed this reserved identical-in-substance docket because the United States Environmental Protection Agency did not amend its underground injection control regulations during the update period of January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018.	5-0

PCB 18-83	John D. Warsaw v. IEPA (UST Appeal) – The Board accepted for hearing this underground storage tank appeal involving a site in Tazewell County.	5-0

PCB 19-2	Reliable Stores, Inc. v. Office of State Fire Marshal (UST Appeal) – The Board accepted the petition for review as timely but directed petitioner to file an amended petition remedying the deficiencies identified in the order on or before August 27, 2018, or the appeal will be subject to dismissal.	5-0
PCB 19-3	Village of Hazel Crest v. IEPA (Air - Permit Appeal) – The Board accepted for hearing this air permit appeal involving a site in Cook County.	5-0
PCB 19-4	People of the State of Illinois v. Peoria Barge Terminal, Inc., and Morton Salt, Inc. (Water – Enforcement) – The Board accepted for hearing this water enforcement action involving a site in Peoria County.	5-0
PCB 19-5	Brummer Porkers v. IEPA (Water – Tax Certification) – The Board found and certified that specified facilities of Brummer Porkers located in Effingham County are pollution control facilities for the purpose of preferential tax treatment under the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2016)).	5-0
