

PUBLIC NOTICE On July 20, 2015, the Village of Orland Park (Cook and Will Counties), filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") a Petition for Variance under Title IX of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"). Variances may be granted pursuant to Section 35 of the Act (415 ILCS 5/35) and 35 Ill. Admin. Code Part 104. The Village requests a variance from the deadline for complying with the new water quality chloride standards at 35 Ill. Admin. Code 302.407(g)(2) and (g)(3). Any person may request a hearing by filing with the Board a written objection to the grant of the variance, together with a written request for hearing, within twenty-one (21) days after the publication of this Notice. A copy of the Village's Petition for Variance is available from the Clerk of the Board and the Clerk's Office On-line System ("COOL"). The Clerk of the Board may be contacted at the following address and phone number: Illinois Pollution Control Board, James R. Thompson Center, 100 W. Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601; (312) 814-3620. COOL may be accessed from the Board's website at <http://www.ipeb.state.il.us>. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") is preparing a recommendation, which shall be filed forty-five (45) after the filing of the petition, unless the deadline is waived. All inquiries should be addressed to Stefanie Diers, Assistant Counsel, Division of Legal Counsel, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, Post Office Box 19276, Springfield, IL 62794-9276. Ms. Diers may be reached at (217)782-5544 or stefanie.diers@illinois.gov. A hearing may be held after the filing of the Illinois EPA recommendation. The record of this proceeding remains open for written comment forty-five (45) days after filing of the Illinois EPA recommendation. Comments must be mailed to the Board at the above address for the Clerk of the Board. The record in this variance proceeding is available at the Board's office for inspection, except those portions that are protected from disclosure under 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 130. Procedures are available whereby disclosure may be sought by the public.
