## ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD August 22, 1984

VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, Petitioner, v. PCB 83-164 ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, Respondent.

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On August 9, 1984, West Dundee filed a letter seeking clarification of the termination date in the variance granted in the Board's June 29 Opinion and Order. The clarification West Dundee seeks is to change the termination date for the variance from April 30, 1985, to November 1, 1985. The Board will treat this letter as a motion for reconsideration and modification. The motion is granted.

Paragraph number one of the Board's June 29, 1984, Order is hereby modified to read "This variance shall expire <u>November 1, 1985</u>, or as soon as the two new drift wells are developed and producing potable water, whichever occurs sconer."

The 45 day acceptance period runs from the date of this Order.
