ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.K. Carter):

On September 20, 2018, Sheridan-Joliet Land Development, LLC and Sheridan Sand & Gravel Co. (collectively, Sheridan) filed two petitions asking the Board to review two determinations of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) concerning Sheridan's clean construction or demolition debris (CCDD) facilities located at 105 South Wiensland Road (Wiensland Site) and 2679 North 4201 Road (N4201 Site) in Sheridan, LaSalle County. On October 4, 2018, the Board accepted the petitions for hearing, docketing the Wiensland Site permit appeal as PCB 19-60 and the N4201 Site as PCB 19-61.

Upon its own motion or the motion of any party, the Board may consolidate two or more proceedings for hearing, decision, or both. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.406. The parties, the type of facility at issue, the Agency's reasons for denial, and the burden of proof are the same in both appeals. The Board finds that consolidating the appeals "is in the interest of convenient, expeditious, and complete determination of claims" and "would not cause material prejudice to any party." *Id.* Therefore, the Board, on its own motion, consolidates the two appeals for hearing and decision.
