ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.K. Carter):

On two separate occasions, The Premcor Refining Group, Inc. (Premcor) petitioned the Board to review two versions of a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). *See Premcor Refining Grp., Inc. v. IEPA*, PCB 07-30 (Nov. 16, 2006); *Premcor Refining Grp., Inc. v. IEPA*, PCB 10-55 (Feb. 4, 2010). The CAAPP permits concern Premcor's petroleum bulk storage and loading terminal located at 201 East Hawthorne in Hartford, Madison County. The Board consolidated the two appeals at the parties' request. *Premcor*, PCB 07-30, PCB 10-55 (consol.), slip op. at 1-2 (Mar. 3, 2016); *see* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.406.

On May 15, 2019, Premcor filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss (Mot.) these consolidated appeals. In its motion, Premcor states that the parties have reached substantial agreement on the contested permit conditions and IEPA issued a modified CAAPP permit. Mot. at 1-2. IEPA does not object the Board granting this motion. *Id.* at 2. The Board grants Premcor's motion, dismisses the consolidated appeals, and closes the docket.
