ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On March 10, 2014, Ameren Energy Generating Company - Hutsonville Power Station (petitioner) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit appeal for the Hutsonville Power Station located at 15142 East 1900th Avenue in Hutsonville, Crawford County. Petitioner filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) in which the Agency included certain conditions in the issuance of a CAAPP permit for the Hutsonville Power Station. Ameren indicates that it has withdrawn all air pollution control permits for the Hutsonville power station. The Board grants petitioner's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
