Illinois Pollution Control Board Notice of Proposed Stipulation And Proposal For Settlement Of Enforcement Case

The Attorney General has brought a case against the Mexichem Specialty Resins, Inc., a Delaware Corporation for violation of State pollution control rules. On Dec. 5, 2014, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing. Any person desiring that a hearing be held may demand a public hearing in this case by filing a written hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the publication of this notice. The hearing request should refer People of the State of Illinois v.
