
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On October 23, 2019, Dynegy Midwest Generation, LLC (Dynegy) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss its Permit Appeal (Mot.). The appeal concerns a permit issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) on September 29, 2005, for Dynegy’s Baldwin Energy Complex under the Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) at Section 39.5 of the Act (45 ILCS 5/39.5 (2018)).

Dynegy’s motion asks that the appeal be voluntarily dismissed, and that each party bear its own costs. Mot. 3. Dynegy also states it contacted the Agency and that the Agency has no objection to the motion. *Id.* The Board grants the motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
