
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.K. Carter):

On November 18, 2019, Enable Mississippi River Transmission, LLC (MRT), formerly known as Centerpoint Energy – Mississippi River Transmission, LLC, filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this permit appeal (Mot.). The appeal concerns a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) on June 14, 2011, for MRT operations in St. Jacob, Madison County. According to MRT, the CAAPP permit improperly aggregated its compressor station with its natural gas storage and transmission facility.

MRT’s motion asks that the appeal be voluntarily dismissed. Mot. 1. MRT also states that it understands the Agency has no objection to the motion. *Id.* The Board grants the motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
