PCB 20-8	People of the State of Illinois v. William Mucci and Debra Mucci, d/b/a B&M Properties; John Kirby; and Polly Kirby (Land, Air – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning a LaSalle County facility, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2018)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered respondents Muccis to pay a total civil penalty of \$6,000 and to cease and desist from future violations.
