
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On December 19, 2005, Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (Authority) timely filed a petition asking the Board to review an August 10, 2005 determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). In that determination, IEPA rejected the Authority's high priority corrective action completion report for its leaking underground petroleum storage tank facility located at the Lincoln Oasis on I-294 east bound, in South Holland, Cook County.

On February 24, 2020, the Authority filed a motion to dismiss this appeal (Mot.). The motion states that the parties have resolved all disputes and that "no outstanding issues remain to be resolved." Mot. at 1. The Board grants the Authority's motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
