I agree on the topical subheading of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 724.171(a) that capitalization should be used. I have changed the text to use capitalization. If there are other similar subheadings that need capitalization, I will make a similar change in each. The problem is that I am so short of time at present, I cannot search the entire 800 pages of text for them. If I see them, I will mark them for change.

I am less clear on dropping the periods from anything other than Section headings. I have not done so at this time.

Of course, the text that I submit to the Board for consideration is only my recommendation. It is the Board itself that determines what text will get adopted and filed.
