portion is August 12 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. and August 13 from noon to 1 p.m. In the June 29th hearing officer order, I requested that members of the public who wish to make a comment during the first hearing please e-mail me. I have pasted that section of the order here:

Members of the public will also be welcome to attend the hearing in person, or via WebEx video and or telephone. Please note that the telephone number is not toll free. The transcript of the entire hearing will be posted in the docket as well and will be available for all to access. The hearing officer requests that if participants know of individuals who would like to provide oral public comment, e-mail the hearing officer so that specific time can be devoted during the second hearing for public comment.

If the hearing room is at capacity, persons wishing to make public comment will be asked to line up outside the room (in a socially distant manner) and will be ushered in to the room to make their comment. If participants will require an interpreter during the above-mentioned public comment periods in the first hearing, e-mail the hearing officer by July 29*, 2020, with the formal request. (**Changed from the original date due to rescheduled hearings*)

If you know of members of the public who would like to participate, please have them e-mail me and state a general time preference. All effort will be made to adhere to their preference and a schedule will be posted in the docket on August 10th at noon with assigned time slots. I will also e-mail this schedule to anyone who has sent in their time slot request. If we call on someone with a reserved time and they are not present in person or on WebEx, we will call on them again after everyone has had a chance to make their comments. We will, of course, also accept members of the public who walk in to the hearing who have not reserved a time slot. They will be given a time based on a first come, first served basis.
