
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Van Wie)

On September 15, 2020, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Beth Emet the Free Synagogue (Beth Emet) may appeal an August 10, 2020 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2018); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.404(b), 105.406. The determination concerns Beth Emet’s underground storage tank (UST) site located at 1224 Dempster Street in Evanston, Cook County. The Illinois EPA partially denied Beth Emet’s request for reimbursement from the UST Fund.

The Board extends the appeal period until December 21, 2020, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2018); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Beth Emet fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
