Thanks for the added corrections. I respond serially to your e-mail as follows:

1. The omission of the page from the Code copy of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 721.104 is an error. I cannot account for the source of the error. We must fix it. Please advise as to how.
2. The comma should appear after "i.e." in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 721.983(a)(3)(D)(i). I have marked the omission for correction in a future rulemaking.
3. The comma should be removed from after "once every 12 months" in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 721.986(c)(4)(B). I have marked the error for correction in a future rulemaking.
4. The words "closed vent" should have appeared as hyphenated "closed-vent" in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 721.989(e)(1)(F)(ii). I have marked the error for correction in a future rulemaking.

A couple of quick last-minute questions:

- 1) In the filed pages, I don't have the page immediately preceding the one on which 721.104(e) starts. Did you omit it or was that a SOS mistake?
- 2) 721.983(a)(3)(D)(i), definition of "C [sub] i" → Should there be a comma after "i.e."?
- 3) 721.986(c)(4)(B): After "at least once every 12 months" the original comma is retained, along with the new period. Can the comma be removed?
- 4) 721.989(e)(1)(F)(ii): Did you intend to leave "closed vent" unhyphenated?

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
