- Failure to identify the particular standards under which a permit is sought. 35 Ill. Adm. Code Section 105.102(a).
- Failure to provise a complete and precise description of the facility or equipment for which a permit is sought, including location. 35 Ill. Adm. Code Section 105.102(a).
- 3) Failure to provide a complete description of contaminant emissions and of proposed methods for their control. 35 Ill. Adm. Code Section 105.102(a).
- Failure to provide other such materials which demonstrate compliance with the Act and regulations.
- 5) Proof of service of the Petition upon the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

Unless an Amended Petition curing the above noted defects is filed within 45 days , this matter will be dismissed.
