Dear Honorable Members of the Illinois Pollution Control Board:

I support Ameren Energy Resources' workers and Illinois Power Holdings' Petition for Air-Variance.

In 2012, the Illinois Pollution Control Board granted Ameren Energy Resources (AER) a variance for the Illinois Multi-Pollutant Standard (MPS). The Board found the variance to be a "net benefit to air quality" and recognized the associated economic benefits. Now, those benefits may be lost if a similar variance is not granted to Dynegy subsidiary Illinois Power Holdings (IPH), which will acquire AER. The variance ensures reduced emissions and high environmental standards while protecting the economic livelihoods of Illinois families.

If granted, IPH will help provide certainty to the employees and communities in Central and Southern Illinois that count on the economic benefit of the continued operation of these facilities. Dynegy is an Illinois employer with a strong environmental track record.

Under the variance granted in September 2012, AER committed to environmental standards and making the required MPS upgrades at its facilities. IPH is committed to fulfilling the obligations under the variance. Please grant this request so we can improve air quality by achieving the cleaner emission standards without having to jeopardize jobs and livelihoods of Illinois residents.

Dear Honorable Members of the Illinois Pollution Control Board,

As an individual employed by an Illinois based supplier to AER and Dynegy, I am personally aware that our company and its employees depend upon a vibrant Illinois power generation industry for our livelihood. Unfortunately, the industry has been hard hit by the national economic crisis and market conditions, particularly here in Illinois. As an individual directly affected by this rulemaking, I am writing to share my support for approval of the above mentioned variance request by Illinois Power Holdings (IPH), a Dynegy subsidiary.

Dynegy has stepped up to help support much-needed union jobs and economic activity in Illinois through the proposed sale of Ameren Energy Resources (AER) to IPH. With this transaction, Dynegy plans to double its operations and investment in Illinois as a responsible neighbor and major employer of highly-skilled, well-paying union jobs.

In September 2012, the Illinois Pollution Control Board granted AER's variance request, recognizing both the environmental and economic benefits of doing so. 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
