OF ENFORCEMENT CASE

The Attorney General has brought two enforcement cases against Sheridan-Joliet Land Development LLC, an Illinois limited-liability company, and Sheridan Sand & Gravel Co., an Illinois corporation (Consolidated: PCB 13-19 and 13-20), for violation of State pollution control rules. On March 28, 2014, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing, as to Bradley Property, LLC and Bradley Auto Spa, LLC only. Any person desiring that a hearing be held may demand a public hearing in this case by filing a written hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the publication of this notice. The hearing request should refer to People of the State of Illinois v. Sheridan-Joliet Land Development, LLC, an Illinois limited-liability company, and Sheridan Sand & Gravel Co., an Illinois corporation (Consolidated: PCB 13-19 and 13-20), and should be mailed to the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
