John T.: Please enter this into docket R16-7 as a public comment.

There is no current hazardous waste number U202 listed in 40 C.F.R. 261.133(f), so there is no land disposal restriction and treatment standard in 40 C.F.R. 268.40.

USEPA adopted hazardous waste number U202 for saccharin in 1980. See 45 Fed> Reg. 33084, 33126 (May 19, 1980). USEPA removed saccharin from the list of hazardous wastes in 2010. USEPA also removed the land disposal restriction and treatment standards for saccharin as part of that action. See 75 Fed> Reg. 78918, 78926 (Dec. 17, 2010).

There are many gaps in the sequential listings of numbered hazardous wastes. USEPA declining to adopt a hazardous waste listing and USEPA removing a hazardous waste listing are two primary reasons for those gaps in numbering.
