IN THE MATTER OF: SITE-SPECIFIC PHOSPHORUS LIMITATION FOR THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE) N R83-12

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

On May 23, 1983 the City of Shelbyville filed a petition for site-specific regulatory relief from the phosphorus water quality standard. On June 27, 1983 the City filed a motion for waiver of the requirement that the proposal be accompanied by a petition signed by at least two hundred persons [35 Ill. Adm. Code 102.121(a)]. That motion is hereby granted.

The petition, however, also fails to include the language of the proposal or a short statement of reasons supporting the proposal as required by 35 Ill. Adm. Code 102.120. Before the Board can accept the proposal and authorize hearings thereon, this information must be submitted.
