RECOMMENDATION OF THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- On November 12, 2020, the Illinois EPA received a request from Pierson Farm (log number TC-143333, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125,204.

The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located in the SE ¼ of Section 28, T16N, R9E of the 4th P.M. in Bureau County, at the above street address and consist of the following:

Livestock waste handling facilities consisting of two concrete manure pits (approximately 203 ft. x 51 ft. 8 ft. each), the concrete slatted portion of the floor over the manure pits that capture and contain waste generated in the barns above, ten pumpout pits (approximately 5 ft. x 6 ft. x 8 ft. each) to allow manure removal from the manure pits, plastic perimeter drainage tiles (approximately 1,050 ft. x 4 in.) located around the footing of the manure pits to prevent flotation of the pits, and two PVC inspection ports (approximately 9 ft. ht. x 12 in. dia. each) attached to the drainage tiles.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport, and/or store livestock waste prior to cropland application, and are further described in Exhibit A.

Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2014), and Section 125.200(a) of the Board's regulations, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), define "pollution control facilities" as:

any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.

- In order to receive preferential tax treatment as pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/11-5
 (2014), pollution control facilities must be certified as such by the Board, 35
 ILCS 200/11-20 (2014) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a).
- Upon receipt of a tax certification application, the Illinois EPA must file a recommendation on the application with the Board, 35 Ill Adm. Code 125.204(a).
- Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facility, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification.

The livestock waste handling facilities consisting of two (2) concrete manure pits (approximately 203 ft. x 51 ft. x 8 ft. each), the concrete slatted portion of the floor over the manure pits that capture and contain waste generated in the barns above, ten (10) pumpout pits (approximately 5 ft. x 6 ft. x 8 ft. each) to allow manure removal from the manure pits, plastic perimeter drainage tiles (approximately 1,050 ft. x 4 in.) located around the footing of the manure pits to prevent flotation of the pits, and two (2) PVC inspection ports (approximately 9 ft. ht. x 12 in. dia. each) attached to the drainage tiles. The facility collects, transports and stores livestock waste prior to cropland application.

The facility is further described in the enclosed applications and supporting documents.
