



**RECOMMENDATION OF THE ILLINOIS
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY**

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

1. On January 4, 2018, and supplemented on October 13, 2020 the Illinois EPA received a request from Raccoon Creek Farm, LLC-Summer (log number TC-139051, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.
2. The facility's address is: Raccoon Creek Farm, LLC

Summer, Illinois 62466

The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located in the NW ¼ of Section 13, T3N, R13W of the 2nd P.M. in Lawrence County, at the above street address and consist of the following:

The facilities consisting of six (6) identical buildings (approximately 500 ft. x 60 ft. each with 3 ft. concrete wall around the parameter). Flocks of turkeys grown inside the buildings with manure accumulated and stored during the same period.

These facilities further described in Exhibit A.

3. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2018), and Section 125.200(a) of the Board's regulations, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), define "pollution control facilities" as:

any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.


4. In order to receive preferential tax treatment as pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/11-5 (2018), pollution control facilities must be certified as such by the Board, 35 ILCS 200/11-20 (2018) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a).
5. Upon receipt of a tax certification application, the Illinois EPA must file a recommendation on the application with the Board, 35 Ill Adm. Code 125.204(a).
6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of these facilities, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that these facilities may **not** be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), because these facilities do not have the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are **not** eligible for tax certification from the Board. Specifically, the Illinois EPA recommends that these facilities be denied tax certification from the Board.

The primary purpose of these facilities is to provide an area that protects animals from predators, shelters animals from outside weather conditions, reduces theft and is not pollution control. Poultry House Construction, by J.G. Halpin and C.A. Ocock (1911) published by The University of Wisconsin, Agricultural Experiment Station states "One of the most essential things in poultry keeping, is to have a suitable house which will protect the fowls from inclement weather and from their natural enemies." Small Scale Poultry Housing, by Phillip J. Clauer (2009) published by Virginia State University, Virginia Cooperative Extension states "A good poultry house protects the birds from the elements

(weather), predators, injury and theft.” Housing Farm Poultry, by W.A. Foster and H.H. Alp (1929) published by The University of Illinois, Agricultural College and Experiment Station states “An ideal poultry house is one that provides throughout the year conditions which approximate those prevailing naturally in the spring.” A Successful Iowa Shed Roof Poultry House, by Geo. M. Turpin and M.F.P. Costelloe (1918) published by the Agricultural Experiment Station Iowa State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts states “This house was planned to meet all the essential requirements of a successful poultry house. Such a house must provide the fowls with adequate protection from bad weather, including both excessive cold and heat, as well as cold winds, rain and snow. ... It should also be planned to furnish more or less protection from vermin and parasites.” The above information confirms the primary purpose of the buildings that houses turkeys is not pollution control. Accordingly, the Illinois EPA recommends that these facilities be denied tax certification by the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board deny the requested tax certification for these facilities. The applicant has 35 days after the date of service to file a petition with the Board to contest the Illinois EPA's recommendation that the tax certification be denied, as discussed above.

The Bureau of Water received a request on January 4, 2018 from Zachary Buchanan for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204. We offer the following recommendation.

The facilities consisting six (6) identical buildings (approximately 500 ft. x 60 ft. each with 3 ft. concrete wall around the parameter). Flock of turkeys grow inside the buildings with mature accumulated and stored during the same period.

The facility is further described in the enclosed applications and supporting documents.

Based on the information included in this submittal, the Bureau of Water has determined that the facilities are not "Pollution Control Facilities" under 35 IAC 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in this section. This determination is based on the following factor(s):

The primary purpose of these facilities is to provide an area that protects animals from predators, shelters animals from outside weather conditions, reduces theft and is not pollution control. Poultry House Construction, by J.G. Halpin and C.A. Ocock (1911) published by The University of Wisconsin, Agricultural Experiment Station states "One of the most essential things in poultry keeping, is to have a suitable house which will protect the fowls from inclement weather and from their natural enemies." Small Scale Poultry Housing, by Phillip J. Clauer (2009) published by Virginia State University, Virginia Cooperative Extension states "A good poultry house protects the birds from the elements (weather), predators, injury and theft." Housing Farm Poultry, by W.A. Foster and H.H. 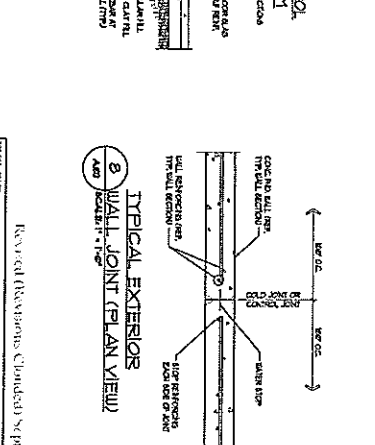
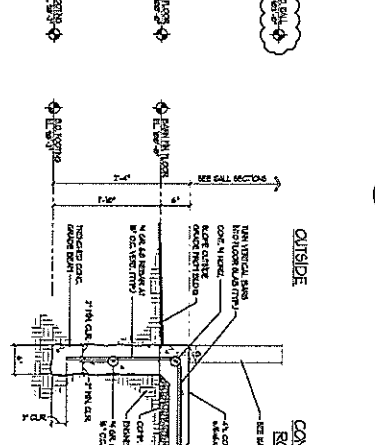
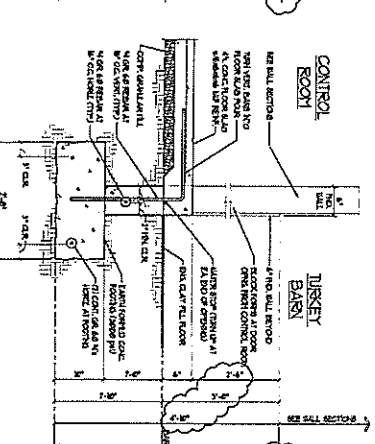
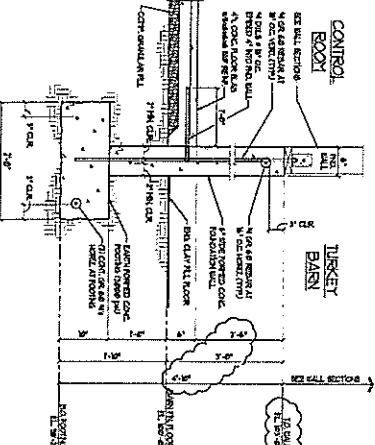
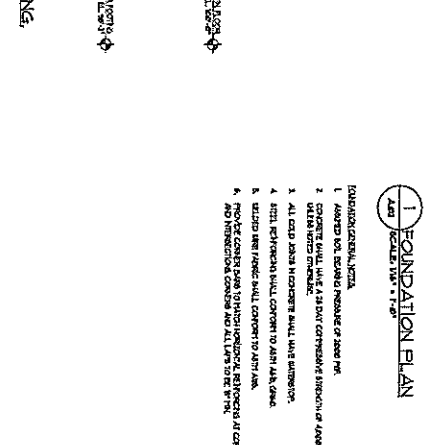
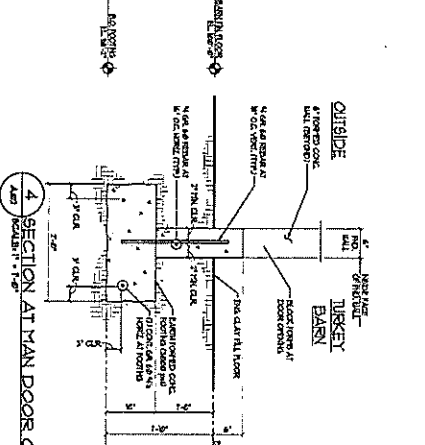
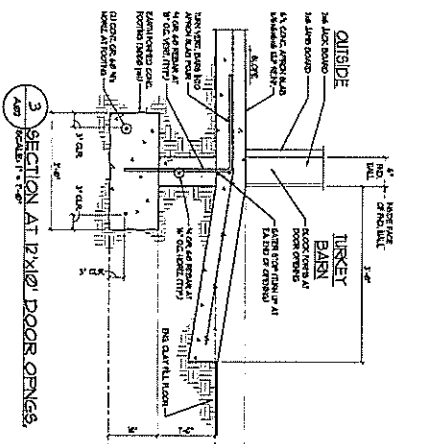
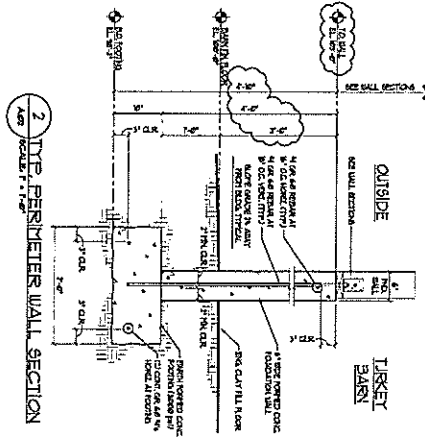
All of the concrete in the drawings provided is required by the Illinois Department of Agriculture for pollution control. There are six buildings that are 500' long and 60' wide with a 4' concrete wall and footer around the perimeter. Manure is accumulated and stored inside the buildings during each 16 week period that it takes to grow a flock of turkeys. Once the turkeys are removed from the buildings, the manure is cleaned out and loaded onto trucks to haul it to the farm fields where it is applied.

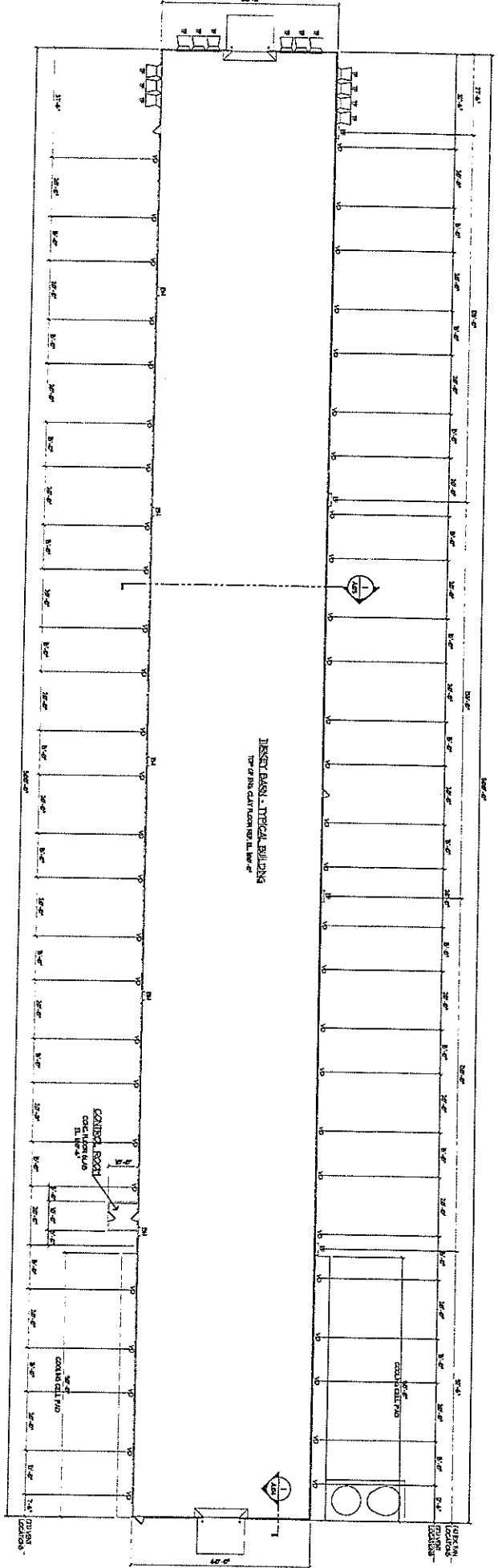
