On December 2, 1981 the National Can Company filed a petition for variance from Rule 205(n) of Chapter 2: Air Pollution. The Board notes that if hearing is waived, that waiver must be accompanied by an affidavit in support of the material facts alleged (Rule 401(b)).

Unless the above-noted defects are cured by the filing of an amended petition within 45 days of the date of this Order, the petition will be subject to dismissal.
