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

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**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY**

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (“Illinois EPA”), by and through its attorneys, and pursuant to Sections 101.500 and 101.502 of the Illinois Pollution Control Board (“Board”) Regulations, requests that the Hearing Officer extend the date for filing Illinois EPA’s Reply brief in this matter for an additional 14 days, until June 26, 2015. In support, the Respondent states as follows:

1. On May 5, 2015, the Hearing Officer set a briefing schedule on the Parties' Motions for Summary Judgment, which called for Respondent to file its Reply by June 12, 2015.

2. The Parties have now initiated discussions regarding a potential agreed resolution of this Permit Appeal and two related matters. Respondent requests an extension of time for filing its Reply to accommodate and enable effective settlement discussions.

3. The requested extension will not cause an unreasonable delay in resolution of this matter. Counsel for Petitioner has been consulted and has no objection to an extension of 14 days, until June 26, 2015.

4. This matter is set for status before the Hearing Officer on June 16, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. At that time the Parties will be able to provide additional information on the possibility of settlement.

WHEREFORE, Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, respectfully requests that the Hearing Officer grant its request and extend the deadline for filing its Reply brief until June 26, 2015.


