ORDER OF THE BOARD (by I. G. Goodman):

This proceeding has been stayed pending resolution of the case docketed People of the State of Illinois v. United States Steel Corporation and Environmental Protection Agency v. United States Steel Corporation, PCB 75-80 and PCB 75-141, Consolidated. The issue in this permit denial appeal involves U.S. Steel's blast furnace at its South Works. Since resolution of the above cases involved a plant-wide compliance plan and the Board has received joint concurrence with its December 2, 1982 Opinion and Order in the consolidated case, this matter is moot. The Joint Stipulation to Dismiss filed January 12, 1983 is construed as a Motion to Dismiss. This matter is hereby dismissed.
