
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.A. Burke):

On March 9, 2011, Freedom Oil Company (Freedom Oil) filed a petition asking the Board to review a January 31, 2011 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). The Agency's determination concerned Freedom Oil's leaking underground storage tank site located at 219 West Van Buren, Clinton, DeWitt County.

On July 10, 2014, Freedom Oil filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss (Mot.) this appeal "pursuant to the parties' mutual agreement." Mot. at 1. The Board grants Freedom Oil's motion, dismisses this appeal, and closes the docket.
