ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On April 24, 2009, Ameren Energy Generating Company (Ameren) and Grand Tower Power Plant (Grand Tower) (collectively petitioners) timely filed a petition (Pet.) asking the Board to review a March 20, 2009, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). See 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2006); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.302(e). The Agency’s determination concerns Ameren’s combustion turbines at Grand Tower Power Plant, which is an electric generating station located at 1820 Power Plant Road, Grand Tower, Jackson County. Petitioners appealed on several grounds including that numerous conditions within the renewed permit are arbitrary, capricious, unnecessary, unauthorized by law, unreasonable, or vague. Pet. at 3-8. Petitioners challenged the inclusion of these conditions and asked the Board to stay their effect until ultimately ruling on the merits. Id. at 8. On May 7, 2009, the Board accepted the permit appeal for hearing.

On May 8, 2014, the Board received a motion to file an amended appeal filed by Grand Tower Energy Center LLC. In that motion, petitioners state that Ameren transferred environmental responsibility and ownership to Grand Tower Energy Center LLC. The motion states that the Agency does not object to the motion.

The Board grants the motion and the petition for review is amended to reflect the change in ownership. The clerk is directed to make the change in the caption of the case and the caption is changed in this order.
