RECOMMENDATION

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- On January 7, 2013, the Illinois EPA received a request from Trevor Dunn (log number TC-01-13, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located at Section 22, T27N,
 R3E of the 3rd PM in Mercer County, at the above street address and consist of the following:

Livestock waste management facility consisting of a concrete manure pit (approximately 391 ft. x 51 ft. x 8 ft.) overrlain by a reinforced concrete slotted floor, 10 concrete pumpout ports (each 6 ft. x 5 ft. x 8 ft.), six-inch diameter perimeter groundwater drain and a sampling port

These pollution control facilities have the primary purpose of collecting, transporting, and/or storing livestock wastes prior to cropland application, and are further described in Exhibit A.

4. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2012), defines "pollution control facilities" as:

"any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: (a) eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or (b) treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or

disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property."

- 5. Pollution control facilities are entitled to preferential tax treatment, 35 ILCS 200/11-5.
- 6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facilities, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the

The Bureau of Water received a request on January 7, 2013 from Trevor Dunn for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 II. Adm. Code 125.204. We offer the following recommendation.

The water pollution control facilities in this request include the following:

Trevon Dunn Trevon Dunn Farms 1836 40th Ave, Aledo, IL 61231

Section 22, T27N, R3E of the 3rd PM in Mercer County.

Livestock waste management facility consists of a concrete manure pit (approximately 391' x 51'8" x 8') overlain by a reinforced concrete slotted floor, 10 concrete pumpout ports (6' x 5' x 8' each), six inch diameter perimeter groundwater drain and a sampling port. Livestock waste is collected, transported, and stored by these facilities prior to application on cropland.

These facilities are further described in the enclosed applications and supporting documents.

Based on the information included in this submittal, it is our engineering judgment that the above proposed facilities may be considered "Pollution Control Facilities" under 35 IAC 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in this section, and therefore eligible for tax certification from the Illinois Pollution Control Board. The Bureau of Water therefore recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification for these facilities.
