
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.A. Burke):

Niebrugge Oil Company (Niebrugge Oil) filed a petition asking the Board to review a determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). The Agency's determination concerns Niebrugge Oil's leaking underground storage tank site located in Moweaqua, Shelby County.

On November 6, 2015, Niebrugge Oil filed a motion to dismiss this appeal, stating that the parties "have been able to resolve their disagreements." The Board grants Niebrugge Oil's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
