ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. O'Leary)

Environmental Recycling and Disposal Services, Inc. (ERDS) appeals the Will County Board's decision granting Waste Management of Illinois' application to expand the Laraway Recycling and Disposal facility.

On June 17, 2016, ERDS filed an amended petition for review, which withdraws its allegation that proceedings before the Will County Board were not fundamentally fair. On June 29, 2016, ERDS filed a motion for leave to file its amended petition *instanter*. The motion states that "all parties have previously agreed" to the motion during a telephone status conference with the hearing officer.

Hearing in this matter is scheduled on July 27, 2016, and the Board notes that the parties have agreed to the motion. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500(d). The Board grants the unopposed motion for leave to file *instanter* and accepts the petition.
